**Downtown employees might consider** leasing permit spaces available at a variety of rates in a number of different locations if perimeter parking doesn't fit their needs. Permit parking is a great option, costing less than paying a meter daily.

**Parking downtown doesn't necessarily mean driving in circles, carrying around pocketfuls of quarters or paying costly tickets. We've heard your concerns and we're doing something about it.**

**With four centrally located visitor parking lots,** there are literally **hundreds** of places to park downtown. **See the map inside for more info.**

**Opening Spring 2009, the new Hill Street parking deck adds 600 spaces to the center of downtown Champaign** and provides a mix of both permit and hourly parking options. The deck accepts credit, debit, cash and merchant validated tickets.

**All downtown parking meters accept CashKeys.** No more digging around in your car, purse or pockets for change. Each time your pre-purchased CashKey is inserted into a meter, 25 cents is debited from your account balance and added to the meter. CashKeys can also be used throughout Champaign, Urbana and the UIUC campus. More information can be found at [www.getdownchampaign.com](http://www.getdownchampaign.com).

**Metered parking in the center of downtown** is priced at a premium of 75 cents per hour (ten cents will get you eight minutes, a quarter buys you twenty minutes, etc) to ensure that parking is available for patrons of downtown businesses. Take an extra few steps, however, and you'll find parking at rates that vary **from 50 cents per hour to absolutely free.**

experience as hassle free as possible, we've  
assembled this guide to parking downtown.  
Just follow the color-coded map and you'll  
be getting down...town in no time.

Downtown Champaign.

Color-coded meter labels make it  
easy to figure out where to park.

**Look for the colored stickers that  
meet your downtown needs:**

- Red = 30 minutes or less to grab  
lunch or coffee to go
- Blue = 2 hour maximum for  
lunch or some light shopping
- Orange = 3 or 4 hour maximum  
for a movie or museum visit
- Green = 10 hour maximum for a  
day-long meeting or outing downtown

Visitor lots are easy to find  
and easy to use.

**Four centrally located visitor parking locations  
where parking is allowed in different time  
increments up to 10 hour maximum:**

- Hill Street Parking Deck
- Neil & Washington Lot
- Market & University Lot
- North First Street Lot

Public parking lots abound.

- Permit parking lots open to  
public after 5pm

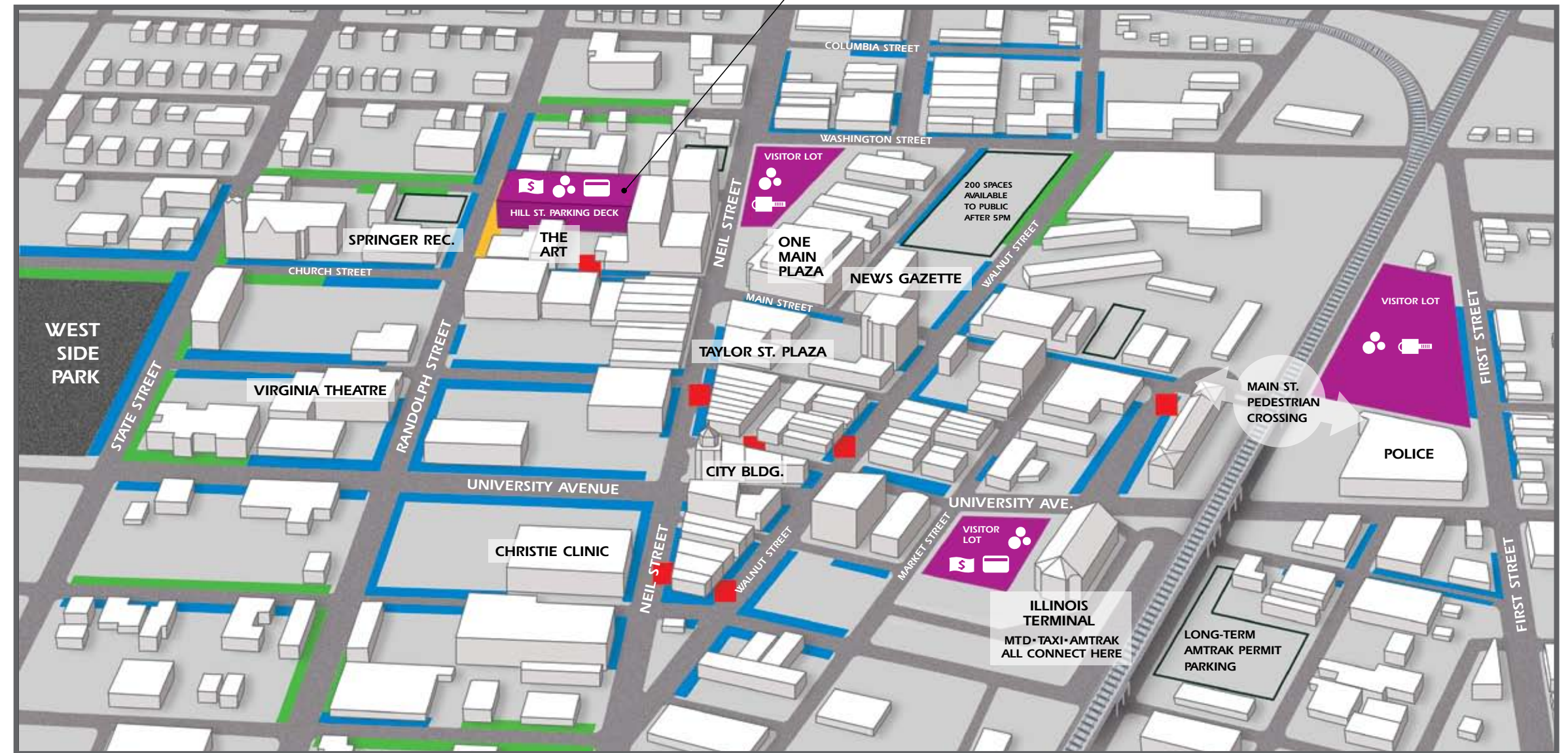
